

Minutes from the Last Club Meeting

March 2, 2018

President Matt Hansen called the meeting to order at 7:43 PM.

The minutes from the last meeting were approved as printed in the *Fender Chatter*.

• Treasurer's Report: Betty Patterson was absent, but provided a treasurer's report which was read by Janice Hutchinson.

• Committee Chairperson Duties Review:

President Matt Hansen and the Committee Chairpersons who were in attendance reviewed the duties of the various Committees, with the intention of giving members an opportunity to try something new by volunteering to chair or help with a committee.

The *Tour Chairperson* keeps the tour calendar, and coordinates giving reports on past tours and the discussion of upcoming tours. It is not the Tour Chair's job to put on tours. Nan Robison has been the Tour Chair for some time and will now hand off those duties to Mark Hutchinson.

The **Swap Meet Chairperson**, traditionally the Vice President, is responsible for the Model T Club booth and coordinating with the V8 Club at the Swap Meet. Russell Hanna expressed concern about the T Club not receiving money for working at the Swap Meet, but Norma said there would still be money for set-up on Thurday, just no gate duty this year.

The **Sunshine Chairperson** sends out cards to Model T Club members who have suffered sickness or the loss of loved ones. Everyone agreed that it was worth getting sick to receive one of Susie Carnegie's wonderful hand-made cards.

The *Club Photo Albums* are being kept by Roy Moffitt. There are 5 albums with photos of members and their cars, but most of these are old pictures as our new pictures are being posted on the internet. We would welcome ideas about the future use/storage of these albums.

The **Safety & Seminars Chairperson**, Mike Robison, coordinates the annual Safety Inspection at the Skidmore's in May. We used to do seminars on specific re-building projects (rear ends, coils, etc.) but that changed when the Antique Auto Ranch opened on Tuesday nights for do-it-yourself-with-help projects. If someone has an idea for a seminar, either about Model T's or something of interest to Model T Wives, see Mike. The *Roster* is being maintained and published by Jim Patterson each year, and is now also being sent electronically. If you haven't received an e-mail with your roster, or you need a hard copy, contact Jim. Refreshments are coordinated by Candy Burgess, who brings in coffee supplies and juice, and makes a pot of coffee for each meeting. She also sends around a cookie sign-up sheet for members willing to bring goodies each month. Nan Robison has offered to help her with Refreshments.

Name Tags & Patches has been taken on by Bill Barr. If you are in need of a name tag, see Bill.

Gene Kicha has been storing our *Llbrary*, a collection of books, magazines, and DVD's that he says needs to be reorganized and put in a better place.

The *Greeting Chairperson*, Joe Swanson, introduces new people who attend our meeting and recognizes those that haven't been here for a while.

Newletter Editors, Jeff and Tammy Hipp, received kudos allaround for producing a first-rate, quality publication.

The *Chair of the Entertainment & Programs* is currently vacant and there were no takers.

Betty Patterson is currently the *Chair of the Banquet Committee* (selecting a place, menu, and entertainment for our annual banquet) and the *Charity* Committee (providing a contact person for members suggesting charities to which the club could make a donation).

Only the *Tour Committee Chair* changed from Nan to Mark at this meeting.

Candy (*Refreshments*) and Gene (*Library*) would both like to have someone take over for them. Everyone else is willing to continue in their current positions, but if you have some time, help is always welcome.

2018 Safety Inspection & Potluck Info





Cat Tails is a big cat sanctuary and wildlife rescue facility licensed by the USDA and a non-profit charity. They rescue big cat "pets" from inhumane living conditions and also take in big cats that can no longer be cared for by their former owners - giving them better quality of life.
