

# Who's the Dipstick NOW? Mike Stormo and Tom Carnegie show off a new Model T oil dipstick idea.



The Tom Carnegie - Mike Stormo Model T Dipstick Mike and Tom have invented a new Model T dipstick so that you can check your oil without lying on the ground. Other advantages include:

 Their dipstick will give a more accurate reading of the amount of oil in your car than relying on when it is coming out of the bottom petcock, but not the top. This dipstick will read all the way to the bottom of the pan.

 The dipstick can be customized with markings showing the exact amount of oil in your specific car.

- It looks period-similar to a Model A dipstick.
- It is easy to install, and because it is attached to the motor it is less apt to break due to vibration.
- You may remove your petcocks completely and plug them if you wish. It is possible to get a better fit on the oil pan.

This new dipstick can be purchased by contacting Tom Carnegie or Mike Stormo. The price is \$40 for Spokane Model T Club members, and \$50 for non-members.




