Meeting of October 4, 2019

President Matt Hansen called the meeting to order at 7:40 p.m.

• **Minutes:** The minutes from the September meeting were approved as printed in the *Fender Chatter*.

◆ Treasure's Report: Betty Patterson was at her grandson's football game, but Jim read the Treasurer's Report, which was accepted as read.

• Welcome: Mark Hutchinson introduced guest Lyle Frink who has his grandfather's collection of Model T parts, primarily for 1915 Touring cars, for sale. He prefers to sell them as a single group. Watch your e-mail for more information.

Matt introduced new members Brian, Joanne, and Austin Sevy, who have a 1926 Roadster Pickup.

Safety & Seminars Report: Mike Robison had nothing to report.

• VP: Vice President Ralph Brevik had nothing to report.

Sunshine Report: Given by Janice Hutchinson in place of Susie Carnegie, who was absent. Susie said she received no reports of illnesses or injuries to send out cards for.

• Tour Reports: Chairman Steve Heid called for tour reports from previous and upcoming tours:

Cory reported that the HASSIE Club Car Show was a big success, attracting 134 cars. They were happy with their decision to host a guest club, and there was a good showing of Model T's. Next year, the HASSIE Club will be hosting the 60th Anniversary of the International Car Show over 4th of July weekend. More info will be coming about this.

Rose and Charley Hodges were ill at home, but Rose organized 29-30 Model T's and 4 Model A's on a record attendance day at the Spokane Interstate Fair. Nan Robison, Rick Carnegie, and Larry Skidmore won prizes in different categories, which Mike Robison categorized as *Too Pretty, Tried Too Hard, and Didn't Try Hard Enough* (not necessarily in that order).

The group that went on Joe Swanson's tour had a beautiful weekend. There were three trailers at the Rodeo Camp Ground, and one poor guy trying to sleep in a hammock. After breakfast, five Model T's toured around the Grotto, Sullivan Lake, had lunch in Metaline Falls, ice cream, and returned to the camp ground for a Dutch oven dinner and dessert. It was a good weekend and a lot of fun.

Janice Hutchinson reported on the final figures from the Cherries to Prairies Tour. Unfortunately since we had budgeted for 50 cars and only had 30 register, we did lose money on this tour, but we still have sufficient seed money in the tour account for the 2020 National Tour in July. Jim Patterson talked about changes (road construction strikes again) to the upcoming October 5th tour in support of Re*Imagine Medical Lake, an initiative to return Medical Lake to the thriving community it was 60-70 years ago.

The annual Montana 500 meeting will take place October 6th at the St. Regis, Montana Community Center.

Steve Heid has a tour planned on October 12 to the Bird Aviation Museum in Hayden Lake. He is planning a tour to the museum, a picnic lunch at Majestic Park, and a tour to the Otis Grill for ice cream.

Matt spent some time talking about the 2020 National Tour and The Vintage Ford, which has already started promoting our tour. This is a great publication, and if you're not a member of the MTFCA, you're missing out on interesting articles, information, and news about upcoming events in the Model T world—and our club in particular. We received good coverage of Montana 500, and you should check out Judy Barnard's picture on the cover of the September/October issue reporting on the Ocean to Ocean Tour. Montana and Judy drove one of the only stock T's on the tour, but we couldn't get Montana to tell us about their trip at the meeting, so you'll have to read about it in The Vintage Ford.

◆ National Tour: The plans for the Tour—now named *T*'s on Tour in the Inland Empire—are coming together quickly, but we will need help from many volunteers. Our next meeting is on October 14. The tour dates are July 18-23, 2020. Old Business: There was no old business to report.

• New Business: October is when we nominate officers for next year. Betty Patterson is ready to "retire" after serving as our Treasurer for 10 years. Bill Barr proposed that we find a way to reward people who volunteer to help with a National Tour, and this will be discussed further at the next National Tour meeting.

● Door Prizes: Brooke Robison drew the winner of the 50/50 drawing: Virginia Warren. Congratulations! Twelve lucky people took home door prizes of fresh eggs from the Hansens' chickens, lotto tickets, or candy. Matt also brought a box of Empire apples to share.
