Remembering H. Allen McSweeney 1926-2020

A long-time resident of Colfax, WA he joined his uncle's Allis-Chalmers business there. Allen was also a long-time Spokane T Club member, had many Model Ts over the years, and had been one of our more active members - driving his T to the Club inspection in 2018 (some 70 miles and back). Over the years he also accumulated a great collection of antiques, which included one of the largest auto wheel lock anti-theft collections in the whole country - which caught the eye of a famous fellow car collector, Jay Leno. Top Left: "Boulevard Flag Holder Kit". Many of us have seen radiator flag decorations of various styles on old cars. They make them new today. What's remarkable is that this 1920s set appears to have never been used. Antique new old stock examples like this should never be used now on your old car - they are worth more as a survivor, as they're only "new" once.

Bottom Left: Model T era "Ford The Universal Car" winged pyramid logo advertising printing block. Used on large printing presses for ads, letterhead, etc as needed by local Ford dealers.

Below: "The Dearborn Independent" from October 10, 1925. This was a weekly newspaper published by Henry Ford from 1919 through Dec 1927. It was sold at Ford dealerships. According to Wikipedia "The paper reached a circulation of 900,000 by 1925, second only to the *New York Daily News*, largely due to a quota system for promotion imposed on Ford dealers." It was full of stories, quips and ads - but was also full of Henry Ford's opposition to America's involvement in World War One and (unfortunately) his eccentric antisemitic views of the world - which caused Ford to cease publication amid many lawsuits. The last issue was published in December 1927. Although it has a checkered past, this paper is also a forgotten part of the Model T story.


