Bob Rankin was one of the original members of the **Northwest Vintage Speedster Club (NWVS)** based out of Portland, OR. Many Spokane T Club folks knew Bob, and during his many years with NWVS he was always a very active member—Prez, VP, Webmaster, Historian, and everything in-between. If you were into speedsters, you most likely knew of Bob Rankin for his love and dedication to the 4-cylinder pre-1928 speedsters.

There will be no services at his request.

Our condolences go out to his wife and family.

In the beginning there was the Santa Clara Speedster Run that was the "Grand-daddy" of them all. It became the genesis of interest in this type of activity. Most of the early Speedster owners from the Great Northwest had to travel to Santa Clara to get their speedster Ya-Ya's out. Paul Murray, Frank Reichlin, Cliff Gooby, John Gilmore and others would generally trek down to California for the yearly big event. There were also some folks from the Portland MTFCA club, Chuck Kroll, Tom Elliott, Don Babbitt, Bill Hills, Bob Rankin, that went south from time to time. (Non) Soup Party Recipes

Unfortunately, the T Club Holiday Soup Party, that is hosted annually by Janice & Mark Hutchinson, has been *cancelled* this year due to C-19. This would have been the 26th annual party. BUT, do not dispair - **Janice** has provided one of her *(secret)* awesome soup recipes for you to make at home for you and yours. We have also included a second great soup recipe that Janice provided five years ago.

Loaded Baked Potato Soup

- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/2 cup flour
- 4 cups milk
- 2 large baking potatoes, about 12 ounces each
- 2 green onions, chopped
- 6 slices bacon
- 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese
- 3/4 cup sour cream
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper

- Bake potatoes, allow to cool, then peel and cut into bite-sized peices.
- · Cook bacon, allow to cool, then crumble and set aside.
- In stock pot or Dutch oven over medium heat melt butter, then whisk in flour until smooth.
- Add milk gradually, whisking constantly until thickened.
- · Stir in potatoes and onions, and bring to a boil, stirring frequently.
- Reduce heat and simmer for 10 minutes.
- Stir in bacon, cheese sour cream. salt and pepper. Stir until cheese is melted.
- · If soup is too thick, stir in additional milk to the desired consistency.
- Enjoy!
- And.... a repeat, in case you missed these from our January 2015 issue:

Janice's Tomato Soup

- 1 quart fresh tomatoes, peeled and chopped
- 1-2 stalks celery, chopped
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 1 carrot, chopped
- 1/2 green pepper, chopped
- 1 cup green beans, cut in bite-sized pieces
- 1 large clove garlic, finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 2-1/2 cups reduced-sodium chicken broth, divided
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 1 teaspoon sugar
- 2-3 tablespoons flour

Mark's Tomato Soup

Open 1 can tomato soup (Campbell's is good). Put into pot and add 1 can water (or milk is o.k.). Heat until it's bubbling hot. Best served with lots of saltines.

- · Saute all vegetables except tomatoes in olive oil.
- Put vegetables, tomatoes, 2 cups of chicken broth, salt, pepper, and sugar into a 2-quart pot.
- Heat to boiling and simmer for at least 20 minutes.
- Blend flour with remaining 1/2 cup chicken broth, and stir gradually into soup.
- Cook for 1 more minute to thicken.
- This also makes a good base to which you can add noodles, rice, beans, or left-over meats or fish.

Please join us in beautiful Eastern Washington! We will be touring to all points of the compass and the city center to give you a sample of the diverse landscapes found here. On most days there will be optional things to do, which you can choose from depending on your interests. Lunches will be provided when we are visiting rural areas. Tour Highlights In-Brief:

Thursday, July 8: Early Registration will be open from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. You may pick up your tour packets and have the whole day on Friday to explore places we will not be able to get to on our tour days. We will have some great suggestions for you!

Friday, July 9: Our Registration Desk will open at 10 a.m. for you to pick up your packets. The rest of the day you may explore on your own: visit our Hospitality Room, take advantage of the many amenities that Northern Quest has to offer, or find information about other sites to visit at the Registration Desk. Don't miss the Ice Cream Social Friday evening-it will be a special treat! And then our tour days begin...

• We travel North to the orchards of Green Bluff. A look at the Green Bluff Growers Map will give you an idea of the many things to do during our visit. The more adventurous may wish to drive up to 6,000 foot Mount Spokane for a look at the view from the top, but the tour will follow beautiful country roads through evergreen forests at a lower altitude.

• We will head East and spend a day in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho on the shores of Lake Coeur d'Alene. Enjoy a dip in the lake, a walk along the boardwalk, shopping, and great food options. If you want to play the Coeur d'Alene Resort's golf course and test yourself against the famous Floating Green, you will have to set-up your own tee time.

• We'll work our way **South**, to the area known as the Palouse, where glacial lakes drained and left behind dune-like rolling hills that are the richest land in the U.S. for growing wheat, barley, chickpeas, and lentils. Most of the drive today will be on quiet country roads perfect for Model T's.

• It's to the West, where the land is more what one would expect of our high desert locale. The West Plains are the eastern edge of the channeled scablands scoured out by great floods during the last Ice Age, and we will be traveling through them to historic Fort Spokane, with lovely views of the Spokane River on our return trip.

• We make the short trip into downtown Spokane to follow the City Drive, a tour of some of Spokane's historic places. There are too many to stop and see them all, but we will give you enough information so that you can pick out your favorites to visit.

Wednesday, July 14: Don't lose track of time on your tour today-Northern Quest puts on a banquet buffet that you won't want to miss!
