He died Dec. 27, 2020 after cancer & stroke complications. Born on Jan 9, 1939. Grew up in Clarkston, WA - longtime resident of Veradale, WA. Preceded in death by his parents Helen C. (Sheppard) & Clarence K. Hipp, sisters Judee, Marilyn & Louise, and wife Marjorie J. (Tracy)(m.1964 d.2003). He was part of the USAF 310 Bomb Wing & also a tail boom refueler. Was a jack of all trades in life: Beekeeper, Spokane Fairgrounds, Construction, HVAC, & School Bus Driver for East Valley until he retired. Was a member of Spokane Model T Club, restored horse-drawn buggies, enjoyed old cars, photography, planes, travel, day trips & antiques. He made a friend everywhere he went, and will be truly missed by many.



# **Model T Aftermarket Items and Accessories**

I think it's fun to collect Model T related items - a legitimate part of the hobby. Below are just a few of the interesting items that I have picked up over the years. I hope you find them interesting too. — Jeff Hipp

**Above and Right Top:** HASSLER SHOCK ABSORBER LETTERHEAD. This is a piece of original N.O.S. letterhead from Hassler that I picked up several years ago. Note their slogan in the top right detail "As a boat o'er water glides, So a Ford with HASSLERS rides". Circa 1920.

**Right Middle:** DOUBLE HASSLERS. These are on my touring. More rare than the single Hasslers, the doubles were intended for heavier commercial vehicles like depot hacks, delivery trucks, etc. that were on a standard T car chassis.

**Right Bottom:** CALORMETER RADIATOR GUAGE. This temperature guage features an arrow pointer, comparable size to the more common (and reproduced) Boyce Motometer Jr. with a mercury thermometer tube. I've tested it and it works fine. I believe these were made in Great Britain by Wilmot Breeden, Ltd. I don't know much else about it - if anyone has info, please let me know.

Please join us in beautiful Eastern Washington! We will be touring to all points of the compass and the city center to give you a sample of the diverse landscapes found here. On most days there will be optional things to do, which you can choose from depending on your interests. Lunches will be provided when we are visiting rural areas. #### **Tour Highlights In-Brief:**

**Thursday, July 8:** Early Registration will be open from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. You may pick up your tour packets and have the whole day on Friday to explore places we will not be able to get to on our tour days. We will have some great suggestions for you!

**Friday, July 9:** Our Registration Desk will open at 10 a.m. for you to pick up your packets. The rest of the day you may explore on your own: visit our Hospitality Room, take advantage of the many amenities that Northern Quest has to offer, or find information about other sites to visit at the Registration Desk. Don't miss the Ice Cream Social Friday evening-it will be a special treat! And then our tour days begin...

• We travel North to the orchards of Green Bluff. A look at the Green Bluff Growers Map will give you an idea of the many things to do during our visit. The more adventurous may wish to drive up to 6,000 foot Mount Spokane for a look at the view from the top, but the tour will follow beautiful country roads through evergreen forests at a lower altitude.

• We will head East and spend a day in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho on the shores of Lake Coeur d'Alene. Enjoy a dip in the lake, a walk along the boardwalk, shopping, and great food options. If you want to play the Coeur d'Alene Resort's golf course and test yourself against the famous Floating Green, you will have to set-up your own tee time.

• We'll work our way **South**, to the area known as the Palouse, where glacial lakes drained and left behind dune-like rolling hills that are the richest land in the U.S. for growing wheat, barley, chickpeas, and lentils. Most of the drive today will be on quiet country roads perfect for Model T's.

• It's to the West, where the land is more what one would expect of our high desert locale. The West Plains are the eastern edge of the channeled scablands scoured out by great floods during the last Ice Age, and we will be traveling through them to historic Fort Spokane, with lovely views of the Spokane River on our return trip.

• We make the short trip into **downtown** Spokane to follow the City Drive, a tour of some of Spokane's historic places. There are too many to stop and see them all, but we will give you enough information so that you can pick out your favorites to visit.

Wednesday, July 14: Don't lose track of time on your tour today-Northern Quest puts on a banquet buffet that you won't want to miss!


