2021 National Tour Reminder - DEADLINES!

The last day to register for the 2021 National Tour-either the full tour or individual days-

is Wednesday, June 9th. We have many ideas still in the planning stages, but here is quick rundown of our tours so far:

Saturday, July 10th we will be touring to Coeur d'Alene to participate in the Pharoah's 1st Annual Car Show at Kootenai County Fairgrounds. Your tour fee includes entry into the show, where they are expecting 600 or more cars to be on display, and you will be eligible for great prizes to be given away throughout the day. We will have a shuttle to downtown Coeur d'Alene so that you can shop, eat, enjoy the lake...without having to find a parking space.

Sunday, July 11th we are travelling through the Palouse. We are planning to stop in Sutton Park in Cheney, then continue as far south as Oakesdale before looping back to Northern Quest. A box lunch is included with your tour fee.

Monday, July 12th we are heading to Green Bluff. We will start at Siemer's Farm, where lunch will be served, but you can plan to eat your way around the Bluff as there will be many places offering special treats for us to enjoy. The more adventurous can join the group heading up to the top of Mount Spokane, but you will need to provide your own Discover Pass to make this trip.

Tuesday, July 13th we will start by going to the Lincoln County Museum in Davenport and then continuing on to Fort Spokane. We will have lunch, included with your tour fee, at the Fort Spokane Park, looking out on the confluence of the Spokane and Columbia Rivers. We will then travel back with beautiful views of the Spokane River.

Wednesday, July 14th we are opening up the tour to all Spokane Model T Club members free of charge. We will begin by touring to Riverfront Park, where we will be able to park in Clock Tower Meadow all day. You may explore the park and downtown on foot from there, or you may continue in your Model T along a modified City Drive route through Spokane. We will also be able tour Dry Fly Distillery. You have the option to stop at any of the sites along the way which will include the Riverside State Park Bowl & Pitcher area (a Discover Pass is required), Manito Park, Moore-Turner Heritage Gardens, and the Northwest Museum of Arts and Culture / Campbell House (entry fees apply). Even though this tour is free, please register so that we have a tour packet with driving directions for you.

Wednesday is also our evening banquet, a buffet dinner at Northern Quest Resort plus door prizes and awards. The banquet is included in the price of the full tour, otherwise you must register and pay for the banquet separately.


