▶ New Business: Rachel Hughes from the MTFCA is looking for donations to the museum as they have a matching contribution in effect. Our charity committee is no longer meeting as it has no chairperson, but anyone can make a motion at a meeting to request a donation for any cause they would like to see us contribute to. There was discussion about making donations, but no motions were made for donations to charity.

We had a request from Moses Lake High School to borrow a car or car parts for their production of It's a Wonderful Life. There was some concern about the weight of putting a Model T on stage, about putting an operable Model T into a closed space because of issues with oil and gas fumes, and about liability insurance should something happen. Nan said she had a non-running car she would be willing to have them use if they were o.k. with the condition it's in. If that does not work out, Model T parts to add to a prop car seem to be feasible.

Dues for 2022 are due! Since the club was able to do so little in 2021, if you paid 2021 dues you do not need to pay in 2022—you are automatically renewed. Everyone please fill out an application form so that we can update our roster. Forms are available on the website and in the *Fender Chatter*. Also, please join the MTFCA. You will receive a subscription to the *Vintage Ford*, which includes many interesting articles about the Model T. Bill Barr won the 50/50 drawing.
