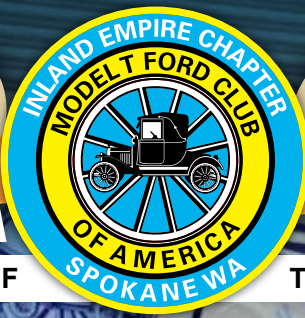

"Pioneer Park comprises two residences which occupied the premises at the address area of 7th & Grand Blvd. One property, which was owned by D. C. Corbin featured gardens, both for flowers and food. The other was the George Turner home, who also bought out Frank Moore's place after he passed away. Turner expanded the existing hillside garden, and added much to it, making it a popular spot for Spokane's high society social functions. These gardens were re-discovered in the 1990's and public interest caused them to be restored and opened to the public. The Corbin Art Center and Moore-Turner Heritage Gardens are owned by Spokane Parks and Recreation. Our docent will give us a short walking tour of this historic area, complete with stories and history of this neighborhood once owned by the elite of Spokane on the lower South Hill." ### Club Picnic Saturday, August 27.

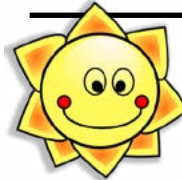

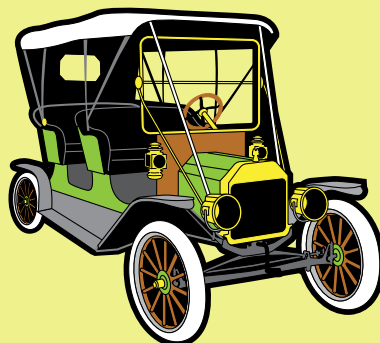

# Model T Show at the Spokane Fair

## Important Info & Deadline - Please Read

### SPOKANE INTERSTATE FAIR MODEL T SHOW

For those T club members who are participating in this year's Spokane Interstate Fair exhibit on Sept. 17th, here is the pertinent information you need to know:

**Participants need to let Nan Robison know Names and year of car BEFORE August 1st!**

### 2022 FAIR AND EXHIBIT THEME:

The fair's theme this year is "All Systems Go!" that can be followed if you wish to freely participate in the competitive exhibit display.

This year our club is going to try to have different categories for anyone who wishes to participate. These will be judged by a team from the club. The categories will be as follows:

- 1.) "Oooo Shiny!!" This is a beauty contest.
- 2.) "Most Honest". This will be for the car that is not necessarily gorgeous, but is used and is part of the owners daily life.
- 3.) "Best Display". This will be a display of the owners choice that compliments your car, or a display of tools, a description and interactive display or whatever you decide.

If everything goes according to plan, there will be prizes in each category.

If you want to add period clothing or other props to your individual display or have items that would go well in the overall club exhibit, please bring them along. If you just wish to have a display, but not be judged, that is ok too.

### SET-UP TIME:

The entrance area is the same as last year. Please plan on arriving at the south parking lot behind the ballpark **at 7:30am** on Saturday morning, Sept. 17th and we'll pre-stage for our car positions, entering the fairgrounds together. All cars must be in place by 9am. **PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE GATES BEFORE YOU ARE ALL STAGED.** I will try to have the cars organized in some way, shape or form and this will be expediated by having everyone outside the gate in the staging area.

### NAME PLACARDS:

We will use the name placards that we have used in the past. If you are new, or did not get yours last year, please let Nan Robison know ASAP and we'll get the information to the appropriate person. If you already have a placard, please bring it (and take care of it for future use, so we don't have to keep printing these).

### FAIR INFORMATION AND TICKETS.

As of now, I do not have information on tickets, etc. I or the fair committee will get that information out asap.

Information will probably be sent out to the general membership by the fair committee. Be advised that our setup, etc. may be different from what is stated by the fair committee to the general populace. Please follow the instructions sent out by our club tour committee. Your compliance will expediate the process and will be greatly appreciated!!

Information will be sent out as it's received, and some changes may need to be made, so please be open minded and flexible. This will greatly help the process.

**THE KERN WATER CIRCULATOR NO. C.** I acquired this very recently. This is an accessory water pump for a Model T, circa 1914, by the G. W. Kern Co., Inc. of Oil City, PA. Instead of replacing the whole water inlet pipe, like many pumps do, this one seems to attach to it thru a hole. Small and compact with a two-blade impellor. This is the only one that I've seen, and I can't find any info about it online. If anyone knows anything about these, please let me know.

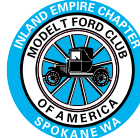

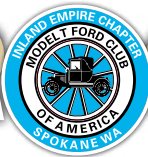

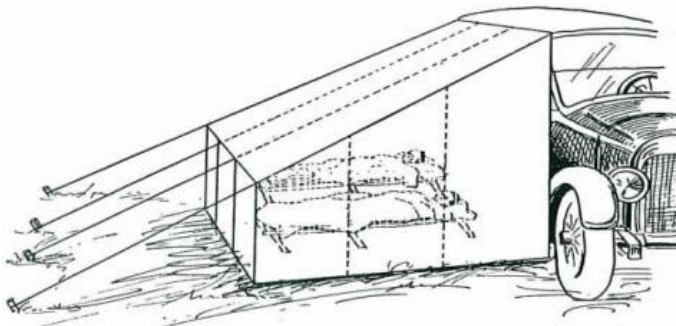
