





Above - 3Z-686 Open End Wrench (23/32" for body bracket bolt) 1917-19 - also found as 5Z-212 (1920-27). This is a Ford shop tool and is one that's harder to find, probably because of its small size, about 3.5". Ford tool parts list shown above right.

Right - Fordson Shop Parts Tag. These were used in Ford shops to attach to, and mark-up parts. This tag is New Old Stock. Red indicates that it is Fordson Tractor, blue would be for automobiles, but shops probably interchanged these at will.
