

Chrysler brought electronic ignition to automobiles.


Samuel L. Jackson's debut film, Together for Days (1972), is considered lost and has no known copies in circulation.



currently in use at Fairchild started production in 1957 (some 30 years after the Model T went out of production) and is still flying in active military service 60-years after being introduced .

After the parade, the T Club members took to the streets to view the many food and craft vendors and to enjoy the bustling activities. It was a fun day which culminated in a trip across the rolling wheat hills to Cheney to have the traditional ice cream treat.
