

Published on Tuesday, January 19, 2010 3:35 PM MST In recognition of its 50th anniversary, the Montana 500 will start in Fairview this June. The endurance race featuring Model Ts traveled from Missoula to Fairview when it started in 1961. To recognize its original route, the Montana 500 will begin in Fairview June 14 and end in Missoula June 16. Ray Trumpower, Fairview Chamber, believes the event will start at the Fairview Bridge.

According to the race's Web site, "The Montana 500 Endurance Run was officially started in 1961 to give Model T owners a chance to get together and share their interest in Model Ts. This is a timed event, perhaps unique in the world, as Montana is one of the last places to allow timed events on their public roads. The Model Ts in this event must be stock, except they can have aluminum pistons, reground cams and the heads and blocks may be milled. The first run started in Missoula and traveled all the way to the North Dakota border – over 500 miles."

There has been participation of more than 30 cars taking part in the event. Sidney is serving as the host city this year. The drivers will spend Monday night in Lewistown and Tuesday night in Lincoln. editor@sidneyherald.com
