ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
INLAND EMPIRE CHAPTER
MODEL T FORD CLUB OF AMERICA

We the undersigned persons, acting as the incorporators of a corporation under the provisions of the Washington State Nonprofit Corporation Law (Revised Code of Washington 24.03), adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such a corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be the Inland Empire Chapter, Model T Ford Club of America.

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (a) The specific and primary purpose is to promote, encourage, foster and cultivate the restoration, preservation, ownership and operation of Model T Ford automobiles.
- (b) The general purposes are to provide technical information to its members and others; provide facilities for competition among its members with their Model T automobiles; sponsor events to encourage the use of such automobiles; provide a publication of a general and technical nature of interest to the owners of such antique automobiles; establish rules and regulations covering the activities of its members; and to provide, sponsor and regulate swap meets, events, tours and exhibitions of Model T cars.

(c) To buy, sell, assemble, distribute and otherwise acquire or to own, hold, use, sell, assign, transfer, exchange, lease, license or otherwise dispose of goods, wares, merchandise and all other personal property of every class and description.

(d) To purchase, acquire, own, hold, use, lease, rent, sublet, sell, exchange, subdivide, maintain, construct, operate and deal in real estate, improved or unimproved, and buildings of any kind or description, real, personal or mixed, and any interest or right therein, including water and water rights, wheresoever situated, either in Washington, other states of the United States, the District of Columbia, territories and possessions of the United States and foreign countries.

(e) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association or corporation, municipality, county, parish, state, territory, government (foreign or domestic) or other municipal or governmental subdivision.

(f) To conduct and carry on, directly or indirectly, research, development and promotional or experimental activities.

(g) To carry on any activity whatsoever, either as principal, agent or partner, which this corporation may deem proper or convenient with any of the foregoing purposes, or otherwise, or which may be calculated directly or indirectly to promote the interests of this corporation; and to conduct its activities, either directly or through the national chapter, in this State, in other states, in the District of Columbia, in the territories and possessions of the United States and in foreign countries.

(h) To have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of Washington upon nonprofit corporations, as such law is now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended.

The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, and the purposes and powers stated in each clause shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in no wise limited or restricted by any reference to or inference from the terms or provisions of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

ARTICLE IV

The procedures for the internal operation of the corporation are listed in the bylaws.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall have one class of members; requirements for membership are stated in the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation shall be E. 3111 32nd, City of Spokane, County of Spokane, Washington; the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation shall be Mr. Carmen R. Breen.

ARTICLE VII

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation shall be five (5) directors. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors of the corporation are as follows:
