Minutes from the Last Club Meeting

October 6, 2017

President Mark Hutchinson called the meeting to order at 7:37 PM.

• Welcoming Committee: No visitors

● Secretary's Report: A motion was made to approve the minutes from the August meeting as printed in the Fender Chatter. The motion was seconded and passed. (These were the latest minutes as the September meeting was cancelled because we did not have a quorum.)

◆ Treasurer's Report: Betty Patterson provided a detailed report. Finances are in good shape. A motion was made, seconded, and passed to approve the report. A separate motion was passed to reimburse Vice President Jim Patterson the amount of \$65.42 for expenses related to the club's participation in the fair.

● Tours Report: Nan Robison said that we had 22 cars for the opening day of the fair and 10-12 on the following day. Jim said that we will probably be invited to participate again next year. Nan also said that we had a good turnout for the Carlson train tour, and that we have been invited to do it again next year. Mike Robison will lead a fall colors tour in the Newman and Hauser lake area on Saturday, October 14.

◆ 2018 Dues: Dues of \$20 per year are payable beginning at this meeting. Everyone's dues paid before January 31, 2018.

● Charity Committee: Betty Patterson led a brief discussion of club charitable contributions for 2018. We can spend a maximum of \$279.57. A motion was made, seconded, and approved to contribute \$80 to the MTFCA Model T Museum and to contribute \$200 to the Scholarship Fund. (Betty graciously volunteered to add 43 cents so that the total contribution can be rounded up to \$280.)

● Old Business: Betty Patterson reported on the 2018 banquet, which will be at Darcy's restaurant, 10512 E. Sprague, on Saturday, January 13 at 6:00 PM. The cost is \$25 per person, and the club must provide a final head count to the restaurant by January 1. (We can't go under this number but the restaurant will allow us to

exceed the number by 10% if we have people who decide to attend after the January 1 deadline.) The buffet dinner will include a choice of prime rib, salmon, chicken, other side dishes, and dessert.

• New Business: Prior to 2018 club officer nominations, Mark Hutchinson led a discussion on what we should do to fulfill our mission as a Model T club. Ideas included:

- Know each other, which we can accomplish if people participate in club activities.
- Promote the Model T hobby. Several people suggested that we need to encourage young people to join, and to make it our goal to grow the club:
 - However, this can be a difficult task as Model T's aren't considered "sexy," that they are considered expensive, and some mechanical skill and knowledge is needed.
 - Participation in car shows might make people more aware of Model T's. Other car clubs do participate in shows, but many of our members don't like shows. (We have tours, but the general public probably wouldn't know about most of them unless they are publicized. The recent Green Bluff tour and the fair were examples of tours that were publicized, resulting in many people seeing our cars.)
 - Bring cars to high schools and colleges so that people can see them.


