

Minutes from the Last Club Meeting

August 3, 2018

President Matt Hansen called the meeting to order at 7:25 p.m.

☛ **Minutes:** The minutes from the June meeting were accepted as printed in the Fender Chatter.

☛ **Treasurer's Report:** Jim Patterson read the Treasurer's report. The Treasurer's report was approved as read.

☛ **Newsletter:** Jim is planning to reduce the number of newsletters that are printed from 40 to 35 as that seems to be all we need. *(And, as always, please take photos while on tours & events and send in.)*

☛ **Sunshine:** There was no Sunshine report, and no one knew of anyone in need of one of Susie's cards.

☛ **Upcoming Events / New Business:** Russell Hanna talked about the Spokane County Fair, where we will be competing for the best display on September 13th & 14th. We have 30 cars signed up so far, and we will have 3 Model A's joining us. Please bring your cars to the South Gate at 7 a.m. on the 13th. You will be able to leave your cars overnight. Each participant will receive a family pack of tickets for entry fees, rides, and food. We will be receiving the tickets in advance--you don't have to wait until the second week to attend the fair. Jim said that the plan is to carryover the theme from the swap meet with Tom Carnegie's 1917X and Russell's huge flag on the flagpole at the main gate. We have plenty of room available to us this year to have a great display. *(see page 5 for more info)*

Tour Chairman Mark Hutchinson also announced that Tom Carnegie is planning an **All Thrills, No Frills** Speedster Run on October 6th contingent on getting help with checkpoints and a trouble trailer driver. Contact Tom if you can help out with this.

President Matt Hansen announced "Montana's Tour" to eat the fish that Matt caught on his recent trip. Sometime in September they are planning a tour and pot-luck salmon bake.

Janice Hutchinson volunteered to chair the 2019 July Rotational Tour. Thank you, Nan, for jumping in with an offer to do this with her! Janice spoke a little about the dates (Thursday, July 4th through Saturday, July 6th, 2019) and the tour format--Thursday registration and perhaps tour to a fireworks display, Friday and Saturday tours of about 100 miles each day, Saturday evening banquet. I've already spoken to a few people and the biggest change will be that after a string of running these out of the Ramada Inn at the airport, we seem to have exhausted our best "West of Spokane" routes and should consider changing to a hotel east of Spokane. The only hotel that I know of with banquet facilities sufficient for the 100-125 people that normally attend and plenty of parking is the Mirabeau in Spokane Valley. If anyone has another hotel suggestion, please let Janice know. She hopes that everyone will think about possible tour

routes and any other ideas that you might have. The pressure is on: Mark and Janice attended the North Idaho Tour in Clarkston this July and many people told us that they are looking forward to coming to Spokane because we always put on great tours.

☛ **Past Events / Old Business:** Charlie Hodges made a motion to reimburse Nan Robison \$200 for expenses for her Driving School Tour. Nan tried to refuse, saying everything was paid for, but we insisted because we thought it was great and we want her to do it again! Nan thanked everyone who came, as she was pretty stressed about people being willing to bring their cars out--which is kind of necessary for a driving school. Everyone who participated enjoyed the horse games played in Model T's and Nan will be planning another Driving School next year.

Nan also talked about Spokane's awesome showing at the Montana 500. Nine of the top ten places (all ten running Rick Carnegie engines) were taken by Spokane people: Tom Carnegie, Bill Mullins, Jillian Robison, Mike Robison, Nan Robison, Mike Stormo, Rick Carnegie, Matt Hansen, Rick Bonebright (from Montana), and Ralph Brevik. Russell Hanna had some bad luck, but we look forward to seeing him make a comeback next year!

Jim Patterson reported that five cars braved the rain at the Medical Lake Founders Day Parade and post-parade lunch, and the fair committee asked him to thank us for sticking it out in the bad weather.

Mark Hutchinson thanked Russell for the excellent Swap Meet booth display this year.

Bill Barr reported that 4 cars attended the Cherry Picker's Trot and Pit Spit at Green Bluff.

Jim Patterson announced that his granddaughter received an INCCC Scholarship.

☛ **Misc:** Mark announced that Rich Hummer's TT is running (hooray!!!) and now he can keep working on getting it ready to tour!

☛ **Club Calendar Project:** Mark is pursuing his Model T Club Calendar project. Larry and Norma Skidmore have a connection that will print wall calendars with Larry's original artwork for \$10 each. We need to know in advance how many to order, and we will need to know fairly soon to get them before 2019 arrives. Spokane County Interstate Fair Car Show Sept 13 and 14, 2018

The T Club's participation will be a two-day event scheduled for Thursday and Friday, Sept.13th and 14th, with the Model T and Model A clubs joining forces together as they did last year. We'll meet at 7:30 AM on the 13th in the south fairgrounds parking lot (behind the ball park) and stage for our entrance into the fairgrounds. All participants should already have their entrance tickets which will be distributed by Russell Hanna, Food vouchers and ride tickets will also be given out as part of a ticket and entertainment packet before we enter the fairgrounds.



Period clothing and individual accessories displays are encouraged but not required.

Each participant and passenger is requested to be present with their car for a few hours each day to provide to the public information and to answer questions they may have while viewing our exhibit. This exhibit is intended to be informational to the public on the Model T's history and importance to the world. Please coordinate when you will be present for either and/or both days with the other car owners so that we have our club's presence is visible during the fair's open hours of 10:00 AM to 7:30 PM daily.

This year, there will be individual car judging for each car display with prizes being awarded for the best display of each day. Period clothing and individual accessory displays are encouraged but not required, however, they will be part of any display judging.


