2019 Fair and Exhibit Theme:

The fair's theme this year is "Pirates of the Carrots and Beans" that can be followed if you wish to freely participate in the competitive exhibit display. There are cash awards for the best three car exhibits as judged by an independent fair judging committee.



If you want to add period clothing or other props to your individual display or have items that would go well in the overall club exhibit, please bring them along. Any teens and 20's era farm or Model T tools for display next to your car would be great!

Set-up Time:

The entrance area is the same as last year. Please plan on arriving at the south parking lot behind the ballpark at **7am** on Saturday morning, Sept. 14th and we'll pre-stage for our car positions, entering the fairgrounds together. All cars must be in place by 9am. We'll should have about 30 Ford's on display.
