September 6, 2019

Rose discussed plans for the Model T display at the Spokane Interstate Fair on Saturday, September 14th, with new cars or cars of new members to be displayed around the flagpole. A motion was approved to reimburse Jim Patterson \$60 for the cost of the car identification signs. If you have received a sign for your car, please take care of it so that it can be used in future years.

On Saturday, October 5, Jim Patterson would like to have some Model T's in Medical Lake from 10 a.m. - 2 p.m to give rides around the town as part of the Re*Imagine Medical Lake community development effort. Lunch will be provided.

Steve Heid is planning a tour on Saturday, October 12 to the Bird Museum at the Pappy Boyington Airfield in Hayden Lake. The museum is dedicated to aviation and inventions. Dr. Forrest Bird's inventions include a resuscitator and an artificial heart valve. We will meet at Albertson's on Trent and Argonne at 9:30, leave for the museum at 10 a.m., and stop for lunch after our visit.
