Meeting Minutes

Club Meeting Minutes of February 5, 2021 Zoom Meeting

This was our first Zoom meeting, attended by Ralph Brevik, Rick Carnegie, Steve & Julie Heid, Gene Kicha, Erik Hutchinson, Mark & Janice Hutchinson, Larry Mann, Jim Patterson, Nan Robison, Karma Roth, Daryl & Tina Skomer, Ron Stose, and Joe Swanson (hope I didn't miss anyone!)

President Steve Heid called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

➡ **Club Dues, Membership & Roster:** Our first subject was to discuss the payment of dues for 2021 and how it will affect our MTFCA liability insurance, which still requires that at least 50% of our members also be members of the MTFCA. Treasurer Karma Roth reported that 27 people have paid their dues for 2021. Steve said that since we had so few meetings and tours in 2020, and our only expense is people who receive hard copies of the newsletter, that we should find a way to give people a break on dues. Steve proposed that we produce a roster with the names of those people who paid in 2021, which will satisfy the requirements of the MTFCA, and that we distribute it by email only because the cost of printing it is one of our larger expenses. Those people who paid in 2021 will receive credit for paying next year's dues as well. The requirement that our officers be paid members of both the Spokane and National clubs is still in place.

Jim Patterson stated that the criteria for life membership is to have a spouse die or to be 80 years of age or older. He questioned whether we should change these criteria given the current situation. Steve felt that we should wait until we can have in-person meetings again before we decide on any changes. We agreed with this and to adopt Steve's plan.

➡ **Treasurer's Report:** Karma read the Treasurer's report. She has paid for the post office box rental. She also said she has scholarship applications available for anyone who needs one, and Jim was asked to send out an email regarding the scholarship applications.

➡ **National Tour Report:** We haven't been able to have meetings, but we have been working on next summer's National Tour. There are 84 cars and 164 people registered. There will be special rates available to Spokane club members so that they can choose to attend only the days of the tour that wish to. We will be getting in touch with people to help during the tour, especially with assistance in parking cars. If you are planning to book a room at Northern Quest, you must use the telephone number and booking ID on the registration form and on our website to receive our discounted rate. It has also been announced that the MTFCA National Meeting will be held at Northern Quest just prior to our tour if this is something you wish to attend. (see page 8 for a more recent update)

We have been told that the Hauser Lake Fire Station may be available to us again next month. Watch your email for information about March's meeting. (see page 5 for time & address)

➡ **Local Tours:** The only tour that we know about is the HASSIE Club's Antique Tour in Coeur d'Alene on February 20th. The Pharaoh's Car Club is also having a show at the Kootenai County Fairgrounds on July 10th. Nan Robison reported that Mike said there is no news about the swap meet yet.

➡ **Sunshine Report:** There was no Sunshine news from Susie Carnegie, but Julie Heid is finally feeling better, and Wanda Hummer is looking well after receiving her second new knee.

Happy 63rd Birthday to Joe Swanson today, and also Happy Birthday to Mike Robison!

➡ **Newsletter:** Jim Patterson announced that he is ready to retire from the job of sending out the newsletter. Watch your email for a description of what that includes, and if your interested, contact Jim or Steve.







Model T Show, Tell and Share

On This Page: RAGTIME SHEET MUSIC, *I Didn't Raise My Ford to be A Jitney* words and music by Jack Frost. Published in 1915, by Frank K. Root & Co. One of many Model T songs of the era.

The Model T was easy to poke fun of in early 20th century American culture. It had many nicknames - all making light of the car being cheap, smaller and embarrassing to be seen in. The name "**Jitney**" was most-popular between 1900 and 1950. Used early-on as a name for a five-cent piece, then as a term for a bus or other vehicle carrying passengers for a low fare.

LYRICS 1st VERSE: Hiram Lord from Wellsboro, He bought a Ford a week ago, And he paid for it in regular dough, Then took a trip to town; While goin' up the big main street, A man whose nerve could not be beat, jumped right up in to His back seat, But Hi he slowed right down. The man said as he held five cents, "The jitney bus is sure immense." But his anger was intense As he turned to him and said, "Get out! Get out! I know you hate to walk. No doubt! No doubt! But 'tain't no use to talk." **CHORUS:** I didn't raise my Ford to be a jitney bus, So don't humiliate my poor machine; — Henry Ford made walking a pleasure, But don't take my little treasure, Or I'll run you out of gasoline. — You'd better take the street car right a way, sir, You're the meanest man I've ever seen; — You're in an awful pickle, Take back your goll darned nickel, I didn't raise my Ford to be a Jitney. I ney. *Then the 2nd verse.... (note that the words "goll darned" was scratched out [too offensive for whomever owned this] and "mean old" was penciled in.)* 😊



Seen, Heard and Shared

A 100 YEAR COMPARISON OF THE 1921 MODEL T FORD TO A 2021 CHEVROLET SPARK

As all of us realize, there have been literally thousands of design changes, technical modification improvements, inventions, safety features, and countless other amenities added to our automobiles since they were patented in the late 1800's. With this in mind, I thought it would be fun to record some of the more obvious changes that have taken place in the last 100 years, especially considering the fact that many of our Ts have, or are nearing that magic "100 years" old mark. To do this, we'll reference technical documents, magazines, auto advertisements, people's memories, and countless other sources of automotive technology.

The "car" as we know it now, came about during the very late 19th century and continued on during all of the 20th century, with the rapid technology changes taking place at logarithmic paces.

To emphasize the changes we've all seen, we'll start with some basic data for the year 1921 Model T Ford and compare it to the 2021 Chevrolet Spark, both being cars of roughly the same overall body length, and similar passenger capacity.




