

Club Meeting Minutes of March 5, 2021 Meeting

We will be meeting at the Hauser Lake Fire Department again in April. As the weather warms up we will start having outdoor meetings again.

➔ **Treasurer's Report:** Karma Roth reported that we have 32 members paid. If you belong to the MTFCA, please email your membership number to Karma for the roster to help us meet the 50% threshold to qualify for MTFCA insurance.

The minutes from the February meeting were approved as printed in the *Fender Chatter*.

➔ **Tuesday Nights at the Ranch:** Antique Auto Ranch will begin opening on Tuesday nights again as soon as Washington moves to Phase 3—which scheduled to happen on March 22.

➔ **Club Scrap Books & Library:** Roy Moffit has the scrap books if you'd like to see the club's old pictures. Myron Richardson has been checking books out of the library and Brooks Johnson says it's the first time anything's been checked out in 10 years.

➔ **Name tags:** If anyone needs a new name tag, please contact Bill Barr.

Closer to home, Steve was told that there will be a Spokane Swap Meet in July, probably outdoors only, unless things change with the pandemic. 



Thursday, July 9th in the late afternoon/early evening.

Friday, July 10th all day, the greet people, help them park their trailers, and point them in the direction of the registration room. We want to have enough people signed up as greeters so that no one has to be out in the heat for long.

Registration will be open on Thursday from 3pm-7pm and Friday from 10am-5pm.


