

September 16: Model T Display at the entrance to the Spokane County Interstate Fair – just bring your car to show the fairgoers, or think up a fun way to deck it out.


October 7 or 8: Poker Run – We are planning to invite another club to join us on this tour as a poker run is more fun with more people.




Antique Auto Ranch 1973




