Coil Re-building Seminar - Apr. 5th Jim & Betty Patterson
 An upcoming T Club event that some of you may want to attend is a Model T coil rebuilding seminar to be held Saturday, April 5th at 9:00 AM at Jim & Betty Patterson's home in Medical Lake. Jim will have his shop set up so that you can follow the step-by-step rebuilding process at your own pace. Things to bring to rebuild your coils include: rebuildable coils, new coil points (available from Antique Auto Ranch), wire cutters, needle nosed pliers, flat bladed screw driver, soldering iron & solder, and a volt / ohm meter. If you don't have all of these items, we'll share tools with the other participants. We'll also be re-gluing the coil's wood joints, sanding the coil boxes, and re-varnishing them. Once completed, the coils will be set-up and tested on an authentic factory original Model T Coil tester.
 This has been a fun and educational seminar in the past, so come on out. If you don't have any coils to rebuild, then bring some working coils to test and adjust for optimal performance! President Bill Barr said that he got quite a few responses and a few good ideas from his questionnaire.




