New Year's Eve, 1915, was a celebration like no other in Washington State history. This would be the "last call" before prohibition was enacted in Washington, four years before National Prohibition. At the stroke of midnight, every saloon in the state would be out of business; and millions of dollars of revenue from the liquor industry would cease to exist.

But even as people celebrated the coming of a new "dry" year, a lucrative "wet" underworld was forming in Spokane and the Inland Empire. Prohibition had spawned a new type of law-breaker; and unlike the mobsters in the east, most had never engaged in criminal activity before. These rumrunners, bootleggers and moonshiners regarded themselves as entrepreneurs, filling a legitimate demand for liquor; and with Washington's close proximity to Canada, they didn't have to travel far to get their stock. The secluded coves and bays of the Puget Sound and of the Georgia Straights, plus the sparsely-populated land border (so porous it was called "Whiskey Gap"), made the area a Rumrunner's Paradise.


