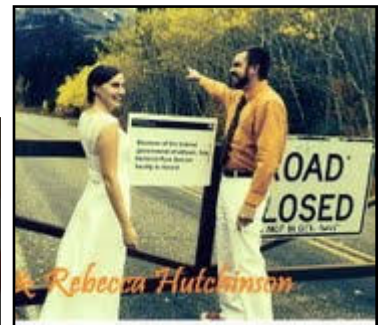


Photo for Fender Chatter of Erik & Rebecca's wedding day. - Oct. 12, 2013



Darrell reported on a trip to the "Henry Ford " that he and Tina had recently returned from and shared some photos.

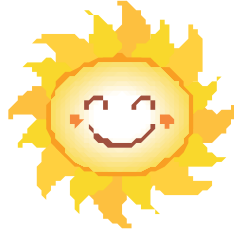
Ed won the drawing. Bill Barr brought several Harbor Frieght items that were raffled off.

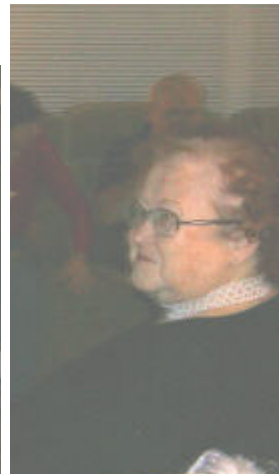
