

## Model T Gas Tank Tip

Thought I'd show you all what happens to the old original type of gas tank sealer when you empty the gas tank and let it dry out several weeks before re-filling it. I coated my '14 Speedster's tank in the mid-to-late 80's before gasoline was laced with ethanol. I've heard that ethanol would eat up the old type of gas tank sealer, but I didn't realize it would come out in chucks like this! I fished these chunks out through the top of the gas tank with a spring loaded 24" spider grabber. I also installed a 1-1/2" copper riser tube in the bottom gas tank fitting so any additional sediment would settle below the level of the inlet to the fuel line and sediment bulb. I had a full tank of gas and still ran out across the street from a gas station because of a plugged fuel line caused by this stuff! I'm still trying to convince Betty that I really didn't run out of gas - I literally had a full tank! That's a 24" garbage can lid in the picture holding all of the chunks, so you get a visual of the size and quantity of the deteriorated sealer. I understand there is a new "ethanol" resistant sealer available on the market now. I think I'll get

some and try it! Jim Patterson
