It is with deep regret that we announce the passing of Alan Stacey this evening around 5:00 PM. Alan went into the hospital yesterday with kidney failure, and later had emergency heart surgery. His health has been gradually deteriorating over the past few months, but he always maintained his smile, sense of humor, and willingness to volunteer and help wherever needed. He was especially close to the people of the Spokane Model T Club and the Inland Northwest Car Club Council, holding officer positions in both clubs in recent years. He currently was vicepresident of the T Club, and just this last Labor Day weekend, he and Suzie volunteered for a speedster run checkpoint, while also taking over 750 photographs of the 35 speedsters along the route. He was also the tour route chairman for this year's Car Club Council's "Park-It" tour which is scheduled for this coming Sunday. Alan & Suzie always enjoyed participating and organizing many functions, including nursing home visits, food bank collections, and other charitable fund raising events where they often took either their '15 Roadster / Pickup "Fire-truck". or their beautiful '27 Pickup Roadster pictured on the right.

In a Celebration of Alan, the memorial Park-It Tour Sept.18th proceeded on the last tour he conceived. Alan had planned the entire tour route for this year. Our heartfelt condolences and prayers go out to Suzie and all of the Stacey family. May Alan rest in peace. Sincerely,

NASCAR returns to town with Spokane 200 **By Doug Pace** 

For the first time in decades big-time stock car racing returns to the Inland Northwest complete with the exposure for the region that comes with hosting a NASCAR event. The Spokane 200 is set at Spokane County Raceway. Many of the facility's recent improvements have been geared toward NASCAR's return, including new retaining walls around the corners and a fresh layer of asphalt in the pit area. This will be the first NASCAR event at the raceway since 1979. Watch for them on the SPEED channel.

In additon:

About 35 of the Northwest Vintage Speedsters lead the races with a couple of exhibition laps before the NASCAR races. T he speedsters turned out to be a real crowd pleaser before a packed audience. A brief Youtube video from the Spokane County Raceway Park taken by navigator Kurt Recknagle with DaJuan Recknagle driving their #444 T Speedster. The NASCAR races held Labor Day Weekend coincided with the "North By Northwest" NWVS Endurance Run. Lot's of fun - as you can tell by listening to DaJuan and Kurt!
