The Spokane Model T Club would like to invite you to the Flashy Chassis Tour. This tour is open to all antique and classic cars, but registration is limited to the first 200 persons. We must receive payment in full with your registration no later than June 1, 2016.

You may contact the Ramada Inn to make hotel reservations at the numbers above. Call before June 10<sup>th</sup> and MENTION TOUR CODE **CGMT07** to receive the discounted room rate of \$79.00 per night. Your room rate includes a full breakfast buffet, served in the dining room from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m. each day. You are welcome to park your RV in the Ramada's parking lot, but there are no RV hook-ups.

For tour participants not staying in the hotel, the breakfast buffet is available at a cost of \$10 for adults and \$7 for children. Your tour fee includes lunch and dinner on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, the day of our banquet. One of our lunches will be served as a picnic, and we recommend that you bring along chairs or blanket. All of the dinners will be served buffet-style in the banquet room at the Ramada Inn. If you have any concerns about meals, please get in touch with us and we will do our best to accommodate you.

On Friday, July 1<sup>st</sup>, tour registration begins at 11 a.m. Our Hospitality Room will be open from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m., and will serve cold lunch fare beginning at noon. Dinner will begin with a Social Hour at 5 p.m., and buffet service will start at 6 p.m.

After dinner on Friday, those of you who are interested can join us on a bus tour to Dry Fly Distilling in downtown Spokane. There will be a tour of this local distillery, and a chance to taste their award-winning vodka, gin, whiskey and bourbon. You will also have an opportunity to enjoy their products at the pub next door.

Our tours will include a day driving through the scenic upper Palouse area south of Spokane, with a visit to a museum containing a lifetime collection of area artifacts; and a day exploring the historic town of Harrington, where you will not want to miss the Studebaker Garage and its "eclectic bunch of car related stuff."
